Statistically, paddle sports are the most dangerous type of boating. Now, there is a course available to address the unique safety needs of paddlers. Paddlesports America is an exciting safety course designed for the novice paddle sport enthusiasts. The July 30-31 course is a collaboration with the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary and Arizona Game and Fish Department focusing on the novice kayaker offering both classroom and calm water instruction.

The classroom instruction on Saturday afternoon will cover topics to prepare you for the Sunday morning on-the-water session, such as:

- The parts and characteristics of paddlecraft
- Before You Go — the basics for predeparture
- Operating Your Boat Safely
- The Legal Requirements of Boating in Arizona and beyond
- Boating emergencies — What to do and minimizing the risk

Bring personal water bottles. Dress appropriately for on-the-water and outdoor activities.

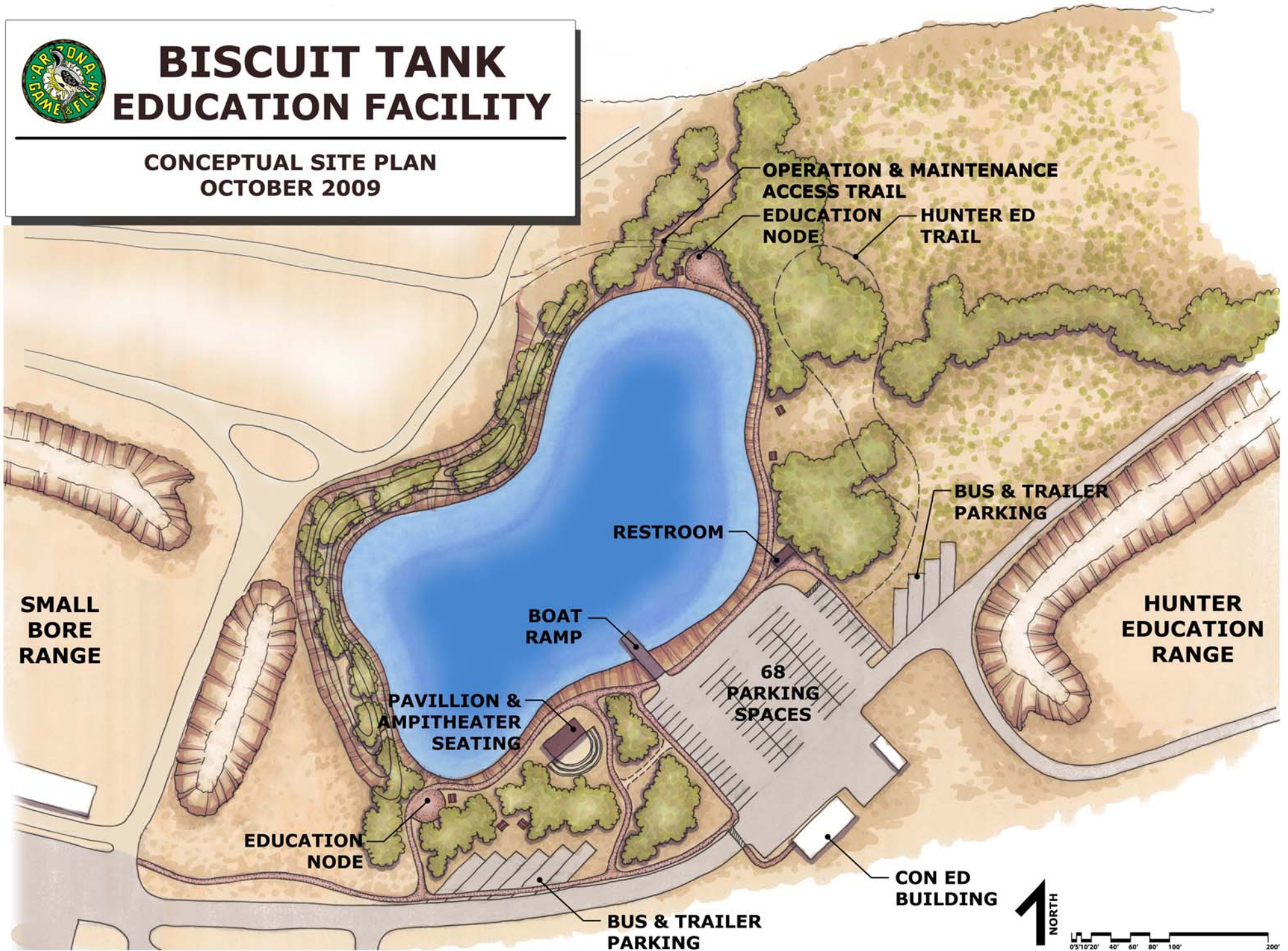
